Overview

Manchester-Essex Regional School District (MERSD) is at the point in its strategic planning cycle where it is time to evaluate and determine the areas of strategic focus for the next 10 years. In order to complete this work, a Steering Committee was assembled to clarify the most pressing issues facing MERSD. This committee completed and contracted the following types of research:

- Content analysis of academic reports available to the MERSD
- Quantitative survey of MERSD parents, students, teachers, administrators, staff, and community members
- World Café conversations with MERSD parents, students, teachers, administrators, staff, and community members

This report summarizes the results of the quantitative study.

Methodology

Creative Education Foundation (CEF) fielded a quantitative survey, distributed by MERSD. This report analyzes 704 responses which were collected in April, 2021.

The survey could be accessed by email links sent out by Manchester Essex Regional Schools. Students were sent an email with a link to participate. A link to participate was made available on the district's website.

The survey consisted of a mix of rating, ranking, and open-ended responses focused on the current Vision of the Graduate, current MERSD vision and mission components, and strategic areas generated by the Steering Committee.

Since results do not reflect random sampling, they should not be generalized to the entire population of community members. Rather, results reflect the perceptions and opinions of those individuals who chose to participate.

Generally speaking, most respondents are positive about the district's performance and MERSD is doing well overall on many of the attributes measured.

- Vision of the Graduate attributes resonate with adult stakeholders; students are more focused on mental health and future readiness.
- Critical Thinker and Empathetic Global Citizen both speak to the need for working with diverse populations and learning and applying critical thinking skills.
- Skills such as working with one another in groups, workplace readiness, diversity of thought, critical thinking, and problem solving skills will all be required in the next decade.

In the next decade, students will need all types of skills.

• "Skills" are not primarily focused on academic skills. Instead, there is a need for social-emotional, interpersonal, critical thinking, financial, communication, technological and other "soft" skills.

Some of MERSD's strengths lie in supportive, caring teachers and curriculum and resources that support students.

- MERSD has great teachers and programs.
- Teachers are described as dedicated, empathetic educators who provide a well-rounded experience.

Recent MERSD graduates display social-emotional awareness, critical thinking, and global citizenship.

Academic achievement is at the basis of what schools are meant to do, so it is not surprising that it is the area of focus ranked highest.

- Key stakeholders rank the most important areas of focus very differently from one another.
- Students are most likely to rank "Preparing students for an unknown future" highest.

There is strong agreement that individualized instruction and critical thinking skills will be important in the next decade.

- Arts, real life readiness, and overall academic excellence should be areas of focus.
- The district will need to continue to focus on the whole child as part of an academically rigorous program.
- MERSD could improve with a focus on individual student needs and more areas of study.

Diversity, community and growth are critical areas of focus for the district.

- A word on antiracist curriculum it is necessary, if difficult.
 - Positive comments frequently have a sense of urgency.
 - Negative comments range from "why bring this up?" to outright outrage.
- While some stakeholders think there is too much focus on social-emotional learning and diversity and equity issues, most others agree that this is important work for the district to do
 - Not everyone likes the focus on social-emotional awareness. Some think that the pendulum has swung too far away from general education.
 - There is a lot of acknowledgement that MERSD is very racially homogenous and some concern that the district tread carefully in its antiracist work, in particular.
 - Those who think there will be too much focus on race and broader social issues also typically believe that school should focus exclusively on academics.










Vision of the Graduate Attribute – Responsible Collaborator








Vision of the Graduate Attribute – Critical Thinker








Vision of the Graduate Attribute – Effective Communicator








Vision of the Graduate Attribute – Personally Accountable








Vision of the Graduate Attribute – Social-Emotional Awareness








Vision of the Graduate Attribute – Innovative and Creative





























Which 3 of these strategies will be most important in the next 10 years and why?






What is something MERSD does extremely well?






