**New High School Sport Proposal: Cheerleading** 

#### **PROPOSAL**

To establish cheerleading as an official sport of Manchester Essex Regional High School.

#### **RATIONALE**

Current members of the Manchester Essex Parks/Recreation cheerleading program have requested to be recognized as an official high school sport at Manchester Essex Regional High School. Without the school's recognition and funding, the cheerleading team is unable to compete in the MIAA/MSAA cheer competitions. These student-athletes desire the opportunity to compete and showcase their skills to a broader audience. Not to mention, the discipline and commitment required to develop a competitive routine will teach students how to be responsible, accountable, respectful, and hardworking citizens. They will also acquire valuable time management skills as they learn how to balance the rigors of academics with athletics.

- Compete in a MIAA/MSAA sponsored competition in the Fall of 2022.
