Military Opt-Out

Under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 which was reauthorized by President Obama in 2015 (Every Student Succeeds Act), high schools are responsible to comply with a request by a military recruiter to access the name, address and telephone number of each secondary school student. The law only allows for an opt-out, not an opt-in. We are also required to provide military recruiters the same assess to secondary school students as we do to post-secondary schools or prospective employers. The U.S. Army has requested the lists of names and contact information for this year's juniors and seniors. If you do not want your child's information released, please send an email to Laurie Carlson (carlsonl@mersd.org) stating that you wish to opt out.
