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In Spanish class in the 7th Grade, we will be using Comprehensible Input to learn Spanish, primarily focusing on listening and speaking at this point, with a lesser emphasis on reading and writing. We will spend as much of the class time as possible listening to and speaking Spanish. While most of our assessments will be based around listening comprehension and speaking, there will be reading comprehension and writing assessments also.

Grades

Grades are based the level of proficiency achieved in the following areas and will be assessed from a combination of classwork and homework:

1. Listening comprehension
2. Speaking
3. Reading comprehension
4. Writing

The 4 proficiency levels are:

- 4- The student is an expert and can go above and beyond
- 3- The student can do this independently and demonstrate understanding
- 2- The student can do this with help or an example
- 1- The student cannot do this yet and needs more practice
