Class Expectations

- Be your own advocate. Stake a claim in the classroom by making sure the teacher knows who you
 are...in a good way.
- Be Engaged! This is even more important if you don't quite understand.
- Ask lots of questions....I can only help if you tell me you are struggling.
- Understand, leaving class not fully understanding what was covered is both normal and expected. For many of you, homework will help that. For others, extra time may be needed.. It is expected that you understand the directions to assignments before you leave class. Be an active participant not a passive one.
- Communicate your struggles to your teacher.
- Each student is responsible for **all class work missed**, regardless of the reason for absence.
- If you **miss a class**, the best way to find out what was missed is through the Google Classroom. If you are unsure, ask a friend or the teacher.
- Be respectful and helpful. Everyone is here to learn and increase their skills. See parties on back of syllabus.
- Cellphones...Are to be kept off and away.


