- Spending growth has stabilized
 - Low single digit growth in recent years
 - Assuming transportation costs increase w/new bid in FY18
- Ongoing user fee deficit of \$20-\$25K/yr
 - About 15% below level necessary to sustain2.5% cost growth

Changes in MERSD Fee Structure

Current: Pay per Sport

- Beginning FY15:
 - \$400 1st sport HS; \$320 MS
 - \$250 2nd sport HS; \$200 MS
 - \$100 3rd sport HS; \$80 MS
- Total Collected \$200-212K/yr
 - vs. \$230K budget target
- 1.6 sports played per athlete
- Theory: flexibility to play/pay as much or as little as desired

Proposed: Pay per Sport

- Maintain pay per sport structure
 - Increased choice for students/families
- Consider 15% fee increase in FY18 to minimize losses
 - \$460 1st sport HS; \$370 MS
 - \$290 2nd sport HS; \$230 MS
 - \$115 3rd sport HS; \$95 MS
- Thereafter, assume 2.5% fee growth/yr

Bus Fees

- \$180 flat fee/yr, no family cap (\$1.00/day)
 - Applies only to riders <1.5 miles from school; others ride free
- Collections:
 - FY17: \$19.6K (equivalent of 109 passes)
 - FY16: \$24.1K (134 passes)
 - FY15: \$24.1K (134 passes)
 - Original revenue target: \$30K
- Covers 27% of non-reimbursable transportation charges (\$89K) for riders <1.5 miles
 - DESE reimburses 73% of costs for riders >1.5 miles
- PROPOSE: increase fee to \$225/yr (\$1.25/day)
 - Forecast revenue growth of \$4K to \$23.6K

Student Parking

- \$75/student per year (42¢/day)
- Senior priority then juniors
- Collections:
 - FY17: \$5,430 (72 students)
 - FY16: \$5,550 (74 students)
 - FY15: \$5,250 (70 students)
- PROPOSE: Increase fee to \$135/yr (75¢/day)
 - Forecast revenue growth of \$4.4K to \$9,855

No charge for School/Municipal/PTO usage, although a cost recoupment fee may apply for these groups if using facilities after hours on a recurring basis. The School Business Manager will negotiate with all other groups that use facilities on a recurring basis.

Category 1 Includes: Manchester and Essex youth recreation and enrichment programs, booster clubs, local scouting units

youth athletic group activities, Manchester and Essex adult recreational athletic program

Category 2 Includes: Any functions sponsored by Category 1 groups that are ticketed, or at which concessions will be sold

Category 3 Includes: Private functions, for-profit organizations and all groups that are external to the Manchester and Essex communities

Summer camps running during business hours will be charged 1 hour of custodial time per day at the Category 2 rate.

^{*}Use of cafeteria facilities requires a district cafeteria worker for health and safety reasons.

^{**} Use will be restricted to selected groups/functions

^{***} Use of any District Auditorium requires a technical supervisor at the rate of \$30.00 per hour if lighting systems and/or sound system use is needed.

Building Use - Financials

- 3 year revenue
 - FY16: \$59.7K
 - FY15: \$49.3K
 - FY14: \$58.6K
- 58% of revenue = community group, at cost
- Fund Balance/Reserve:
 - After cost of operation (e.g. custodial, maintenance, utilities)
 - \$114K current FB: set aside for eventual turf replacement (2 fields @\$300-400K ea)
